DURING the next hundred and fifty years the demand for coinage expanded enormously, and by the 1960s it was clear that the Tower Hill site was inadequate. With substantial orders for coinage for overseas countries and the need to issue an entirely new decimal currency for the United Kingdom, the decision was taken to build a new mint at Llantrisant, a few miles north-west of Cardiff, capital city of Wales.

IN 1968 Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II struck the first coin at Llantrisant. Meanwhile, Tower Hill continued striking limited quantities of coin until 1975, when the last coin, a gold sovereign, was ceremonially struck to mark the end of over 1000 years of minting in London.

The Royal Mint and America

Although some British coin found its way across the Atlantic, only one special coinage was undertaken by the Royal Mint for the American colonies during the eighteenth century. This was an issue of copper halfpennies for the Colony of Virginia in 1773, shortly before

the outbreak of the War of Independence. The coin shows on the obverse the portrait of King George III, who was Monarch at the time. On the reverse appears the Arms of Virginia together with the name of the Colony and the date.
