

Gibbons values covers at 6x+ value of used stamps. Sc value of stamp is \$1.75 resulting in an unrealistically low value for this unusual cover. Paid \$100





Franked with a single copy of Sc.67 which paid the proper 1d. letter rate within the British Empire. Use of the Lome overprint in 1920 is unusual. Interesting notation on the front reads 'Very urgent'. Wonder if it sped up the delivery? A non-philatelic cover.
